Rules

- Adult officials for all games.
- 3rd & 4th grade will play with a 27.5 basketballs. 5th grade will play with a 28.5 basketball.
- Please arrive 20 minutes before your scheduled game time. If games are running ahead of schedule we will start early. Due to the tight time schedule, games must start on time. Teams may start the game with a minimum of 3 players.
- Warm ups will be 5 minutes. If we are running behind schedule, warm ups will be cut.
- Two 18 minute halves. Running time.
- Stop time, for the last minute of the game.
- 2 minutes for overtime. Clock stops the last minute.
- 2nd overtime will be sudden death.
- Timeouts: each team is awarded three 60 second timeouts per game. Unused timeouts do not carry over to the overtime period. Each team is awarded one timeout per overtime.
- Halftime will be 3 minutes.

<u>Grades</u>	<u>Half Court Defense</u>	<u>Full Court Defense</u>
3	Person to Person Only	Not allowed
4-5	Person to Person Only	Person to Person Only

- 4th & 5th Grade: In the last minute of the game, full court man-to-man defense is allowed except for the team that is leading by 10 points or more. Pressing is also allowed during the last minute of overtime.
- Officials will remind players to stay on their man. If players are not staying on their man the other team will be given 1 point and they will keep the ball.
- Free throw line: 5th grade must start behind the free throw line, but may jump over. 3rd & 4th grade can shoot from the tape line and may also jump over the line.
- Technical foul: no free throws will be shot on technical fouls. Two points and the ball will be awarded to the opposing team. Players/coaches that receive two technical fouls in the same game will be suspended from the tournament.
- Teams should have a reversible light and dark jersey.
- Basket Heights
 - 3rd grade 9 feet
 - 4th grade 10 feet
 - 5th grade 10 feet
